< 1 > Rules to Refund Entry/Registration Fees due to Cancellation or Postponement of the Event

- a. JSAE reserves the right to cancel or postpone SETC2022 or to change the schedule or the venue without prior notice, for reason of act of God, terror, etc.
- b. In the case of any such contingency happening before the opening day: JSAE shall refund an entry/registration fee, including participation fees in various events it will have received before the contingency, less related costs.
- c. In the case of any such contingency happening during the international meeting: JSAE shall not refund any entry/registration fees.

For example, in the case where JSAE should be preparing delivery of collected papers to each applicant that has already paid an entry/registration fee before the contingency, the fee less costs of bookbinding, packing and shipping shall be refunded.

No damages or compensation, except the refunding of an entry/registration fee as stated above, shall be recovered from JSAE. Therefore, an air fare, accommodation fee, and other expenses paid by a registered participant shall not be compensated by JSAE but shall be subject to an agreement between the registered participant and businesses in charge.

< 2 > Voice/Picture Recording and Photo Shooting

- a. As a general rule, you are banned to make a voice/video recording and/or to take pictures in relation to technical paper presentation at the venue of the meeting without prior authorization by JSAE.
- b. Photographs and video taken by or on behalf of JSAE of event activities and attendees shall be the property of JSAE. By registering for SETC2022, you consent to the use by JSAE of any photograph or video in which you appear, including for promotional purposes, in print, digital, or other format, without notice or compensation to you.







< 3 > Notice to online participants

- a. It is prohibited to record or distribute online SETC 2022 by any way (including taking pictures, PC screen captures (screen shots), video recording or voice recording) either live streaming or archive streaming.
- b. It is prohibited to disclose your user ID, password, or viewer URL of SETC2022 to non-registered participants. Sharing screen while viewing either live streaming or archive streaming is also prohibited.
- c. Please use the latest version of Zoom to avoid security trouble. Download and install (or upgrade) if necessary. (URL: https://zoom.us/download)
- d. SETC2022 is not liable for any streaming errors or network interruption caused by unexpected/inevitable accidents occurred on the host's network. Nor those affected by your internet circumstances.

< 4 > Necessary preparation for entry to Japan (Foreign Nationals)

SETC2022 welcomes and expects to meet, at the venue, you coming over from abroad as well as domestic attendees. Since you need some preparations to enter Japan, please read the following and check the latest information required.

For foreign nationals of the designated <u>68 countries/regions</u>, VISA exemption measures will be <u>resumed as from October 11</u>. Thus, VISA application will <u>NOT</u> be required for SETC 2022 attendees coming from those countries/regions.

VISA application for foreign nationals from other than the 68 countries/regions are still required.

Furthermore, a certificate issued by Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare will NOT be required for all SETC 2022 attendees who newly enter Japan as from October 11.







1. VISA application

Reception of documents request for VISA application ended on September 25. However, SETC2022 may continue to support SAE members or presenters, though limited. Please refer to web page of Conference Registration for detail.

As a preventive measure against spread of COVID-19, Japanese government has set a new rule that every foreign national who is willing to enter Japan needs a visa for the entry, newly issued by Embassy or Consulate of Japan located in his country.

For your visa application, a certificate issued by Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare needs to be submitted together with other documents required.

SETC2022 is going to help you obtain such a certificate upon your request, if you enter Japan only for the purpose of attending SETC conference.

Please note the responsibility and authority of SETC2022 to this new rule is limited only within the SETC conference.

In case you enter Japan for the purpose of attending SETC2022 conference and other business, please consult a business partner of other business about how to obtain the certificate for your VISA application.

2. Vaccination certificate

All entrants are required to present either the negative COVID test result within 72 hours before leaving your country or COVID-19 vaccination certificate. Depending upon the level of COVID-19 situation, countries are classified into categories of 3 colors (blue, yellow, and red). With a combination of this color category of country and with/without your COVID-19 vaccination certificate, your quarantine procedure will differ.

Please check and read, therefore, the useful information described below.

International travel medical insurance
 It is strongly recommended to get the insurance for your trip to Japan.

4. Useful information

There is some other useful information such as "Fast Track" for quarantine procedure to save time while you are in quarantine/border security at the airport in Japan.
